

Vinyes d'Olivardots was born in 2002 in the town of Capmany, stemming from the passion for the world of wine of Carme Casacuberta, owner, winemaker, and viticulturist, and Antoni Pena, husband and industrial engineer. With a clear objective to work respectfully and to bet on native varieties such as the Carignans from Empordà in all their versions: black, white, and red.

In 2015, their daughter, Carlota Pena, joined the project after finishing her studies in Enology at URV, bringing new concerns and introducing the cellar to biodynamic agriculture. The mother-daughter tandem joins efforts to continue valuing and achieving the essence of a territory like Empordà.

It is worth remembering that in 2016, Vinyes d'Olivardots received the Gran Vinari d'Or and the award for the best wine in Catalonia with the single-varietal Vd'O 1.10 (2010), 100% black Carignan on slate soils. In 2018, they won the Vinari d'Or for the best aged wine in Catalonia with Gresa Expressió 2010, and in 2019, Parker recognized their trajectory with excellent scores for 11 of their wines, with notes ranging from 95 to 93 points. That same year, they were recognized as the Best Winery in Catalonia 2019 at the Sommeliers Night organized by the Catalan Association of Sommeliers (ACS).

Three years later, Parker scored 12 of their wines again with high scores ranging from 94+ to 91 points, highlighting especially that 4 of them obtained 94 points. This year, the scores have been remarkable.
